IMPORTANT INFO!

Daily Activities 9 AM - 3 PM

After attendance and warm-ups, on a typical day campers will receive instruction and participate in drills in throwing, fielding, base running, and defensive play. Hitting instruction and batting practice will usually be the final morning activity. Lunch is held in the warming area at the pool complex, and is followed by a period of recreational swimming. The afternoon is devoted to scrimmages, where campers are organized into teams, and other fun activities. Campers are supervised at all times by Camp staff.
